## Strengthening CoC and Homeless Grantee Reporting

The Knoxville Field Office of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development is sponsoring a one-day training clinic on Financial Management topics relating to the Supportive Housing Program (SHP). This clinic is being presented by Training and Development Associates.



The clinic will offer guidance on major changes in the HUD Continuum of Care rules and regulations, including the HEARTH amendment, Annual Performance Report (APR) and E-SNAPS. The clinic will also provide instruction and guidance on the appropriate income determination and tenant rent calculation methods for CoC grantees. Additionally, HUD program rules and compliance requirements will be discussed.
